

Strauss-Kahn acquitted

Dominique Strauss-Kahn, the former head of the IMF, has been acquitted of “aggravated pimping”



■ **Apr 25, 1949:** Born in Neuilly-sur-Seine near Paris, France

■ **1986:** Elected to National Assembly as French Socialist Party (PS) member

■ **1997-99:** Serves in *Lionel Jospin's* government as finance minister

■ **2006:** Loses out in bid to become president of PS to *Segolene Royal*

■ **2007:** Becomes managing director of International Monetary Fund (IMF)

■ **2008:** Wins praise for IMF's efforts to cope with global financial meltdown. Reprimanded by IMF executive for having affair with colleague

■ **2011:** Resigns after being arrested by New York police on sexual assault allegations

■ **2012:** Signs settlement with hotel maid *Nafissatou Diallo*

■ **2014:** Events inspire film starring *Gerard Depardieu*

■ **Jun 12, 2015:** After four years of legal drama, French court rules DSK innocent of procuring prostitutes for orgies
