



## Today in History

*July 27, 1980*

▲ **Muhammad Reza Shah Pahlavi, the exiled Shah of Iran, died of cancer in Cairo, Egypt. The Shah, who ruled Iran from 1941, was forced to flee his country in 1979**

**1955:** Austria regained sovereignty after 17 years of foreign occupation

**2005:** Mumbai was deluged by over 65cm (26ins) of rain, the heaviest recorded in India's history, during exceptionally heavy monsoon rains which killed over 1,000 people

**2010:** BP set aside \$32.2bn to clean up the Gulf of Mexico oil spill

**2013:** The first Przewalski's horse foal, a female, was born via artificial insemination
