▲ **Palestinian Leila Khaled was arrested in London after trying to hijack an El Al plane to New York. Three other planes hijacked at the same time were later blown up**

1965: India invaded West Pakistan over Kashmir. Almost 2,500 Indians died in the ensuing 17-day war

1988: Thomas Gregory, 11, became the youngest person to swim the English Channel

1991: Russia's second city reverted to its original name of Saint Petersburg

2000: Fidel Castro and Bill Clinton exchanged the first-ever handshake between Cuba's Communist leader and a sitting U.S. president
