

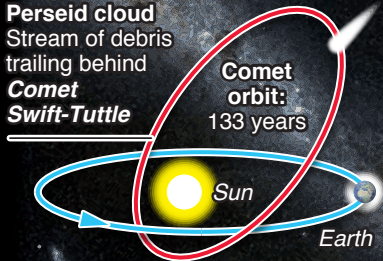
Perseids to coincide with new moon

For the first time since 2007, the annual Perseid meteor shower coincides with a new moon – making for spectacular viewing conditions, weather permitting – with up to 100 shooting stars per hour visible in the Northern Hemisphere
