Foreigners executed by IS militants

More than 60 foreigners – including several Westerners – are believed to have been executed by militants or jihadist movements linked to the so-called Islamic State (IS) group since August 2014





- Aug 19, 2014: IS posts video showing beheading of U.S. journalist *James Foley* (above left), seized in Syria in 2012. Militants also warn that U.S. reporter *Steven Sotloff* (above right) will be killed unless America halts air strikes against IS
- Sep 2: IS says it has beheaded Sotloff, who was abducted in August 2013 near Syrian city of Aleppo
- Sep 13: IS claims to have beheaded British aid worker David Haines seized in Syria in March 2013 blaming Britain for supporting U.S.



- Sep 24: IS-linked Algerian group Jund al-Khilafah releases video showing beheading of French hiker Hervé Gourdel, after Paris rejects IS demands to cease air strikes in Iraq
- Oct 3: IS video shows beheading of British aid worker *Alan Henning*, kidnapped in December 2013 while delivering supplies to Syrian refugees
- Nov 16: IS says it has killed U.S. aid worker *Peter Kassig*, abducted in Syria in October 2013

- Jan 8, 2015: Libyan branch of IS claims to have executed Tunisian journalists *Sofiene Chourabi* and *Nadhir Ktari*, who went missing near Ajdabiya in September 2014
- Jan 24 and 31: IS videos show beheadings of Japanese hostages Haruna Yukawa (below left) and Kenji Goto (below right), after Tokyo fails to meet ransom demand





- Feb 3: IS video shows Jordanian pilot *Lt. Muath al-Kasasbeh*, captured in December 2014 after his plane crashed in Syria, being burned alive inside metal cage
- Feb 15: IS militants in Libya claim mass beheading of 21 Coptic Christians most of them Egyptian kidnapped in city of Sirte
- Apr 19: Video shows IS execution of 28 Ethiopian Christians in Libya
- Aug 12
 IS releases photo showing apparent killing of *Tomislav Salopek*, Croatian hostage captured on July 22 while
