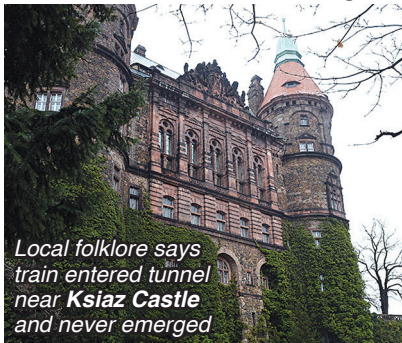


Missing Nazi gold train “discovered”

A legendary Nazi train packed with gold may have been found in a long-forgotten tunnel in the Polish mountains. Two men claim to know where it is, but refuse to divulge its location until a finders fee is agreed

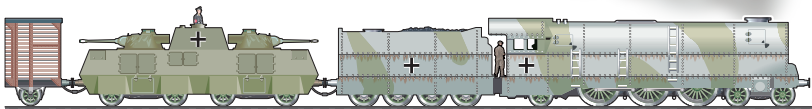
Greater German Reich boundary

GOLD TRAIN LEGEND

- **Nazi occupation, 1939-45:** Haul of precious stones and historical artefacts stripped from Poland, including bank gold reserves
- **Final days of war:** Germans in full retreat as Russian Red Army closes in on city of **Breslau**
- **May 1945:** With treasure at risk of falling into Russian hands, Germans send armoured train to Breslau to retrieve loot – said to include 23 boxes of gold bullion
