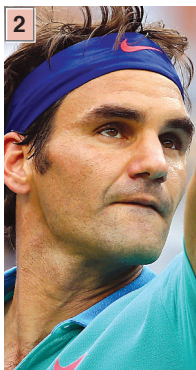
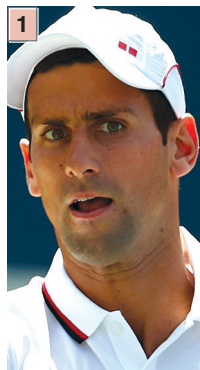


U.S. Open 2015: Men's preview

1 Rank



1 Novak Djokovic (SRB) Age: 28

Aiming for third Grand Slam title of the year, having been denied in Paris by **Wawrinka**. Five-time finalist at Flushing Meadows, with sole victory coming in 2011

3 Andy Murray (GBR) Age: 28

Four titles this year, including Masters in Madrid and Montreal. Bested only by **Djokovic** and **Federer** in Slams, reaching final in Australia and semis at Roland Garros and Wimbledon

2 Roger Federer (SUI) Age: 34

At age 34, five-time U.S. Open champion is back to his best. Lost to **Djokovic** in Wimbledon final but beat him in most recent outing to win record seventh title at Cincinnati Masters

4 Kei Nishikori (JPN) Age: 25

Made history in 2014 as first Japanese player to enter top 10 and first Asian male to reach Grand Slam final at U.S. Open, beating **Djokovic** in semis before losing to Marin Cilic
