


Superb Serena eyes perfect season

Serena Williams returns to Flushing Meadows aiming to become only the fourth woman to claim a calendar Grand Slam – winning all four major titles in a single season. Victory would also bring her a record seventh U.S. Open title



CALENDAR GRAND SLAM WINNERS

1988		Steffi Graf Only player to have won Golden Grand Slam – winning all four majors, plus Olympic title in Seoul. Last player to achieve feat
1970	Margaret Court: Aged 28, became first woman to clinch calendar Grand Slam in Open Era, with powerful, athletic game	
1953	Maureen Connolly: In first year she played all four tournaments, “Little Mo”, 18, dropped only one set throughout
