- 1947, in Chicago, Illinois
- 1973: Graduates from Yale Law School, Meets Bill Clinton while at Yale – they marry in 1975
- Law career: Staff attorney during Watergate inquiry in 1974. Partner in Rose Law Firm from 1979-1992
- 1993-2000: Serves as U.S. First Lady. Campaigns for healthcare reform and women's rights
- 2000: Flected New York Senator. Re-elected in 2006
- 2008: Loses Democratic Party presidential nomination to Barack Obama. Serves as his Secretary of State from 2009-2013
- Apr 2015: Announces 2016 presidential campaign
