1835: Donizetti's opera Lucia di Lammermoor premiered in Naples, Italy

1973: Concorde made its first non-stop crossing of the Atlantic

2005: Northern Ireland's arms decommissioning body confirmed that the IRA had scrapped its entire arsenal of weapons

2008: Flying a fixed-wing jet pack, Swiss pilot and inventor Yves Rossy crossed the English Channel in just over nine minutes at 200km/h
