▲ **Iva Toguri D'Aquino, who as “Tokyo Rose” broadcast Japanese propaganda to American forces in the Pacific during World War II, was jailed for treason in the U.S.**

1890: The Mormons in Utah officially renounced bigamy

1995: Channel Tunnel operators Eurotunnel announced losses of £465 million for the first half of the year, rising to £925 million later the same year

2000: Yugoslav President Slobodan Milosevic resigned following mass street protests in Belgrade
