▲ King Henry V of England led his troops to victory at the Battle of Agincourt, the skills of his archers defeating a French army almost five times bigger than the English

1955: The last Allied occupation forces left Austria

1955: The first domestic microwave oven went on sale, priced at \$1,295

1995: The Middle East peace process took a step forward as the first Palestinian police officers began replacing Israeli troops in the mainly Palestinian West Bank

2005: The number of U.S. soldiers killed in Iraq since the invasion of March 2003 passed 2,000
