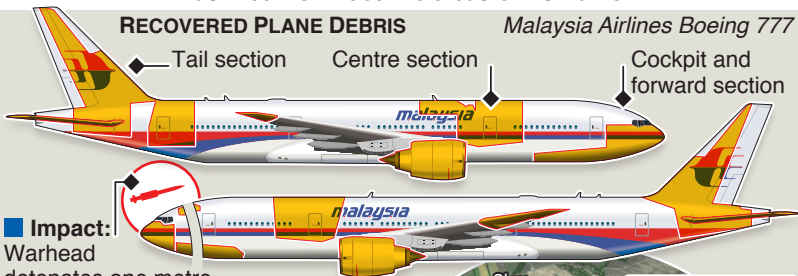


MH17 disaster – summary of findings

Malaysian Airlines Flight MH17 was shot down by a Russian-made Buk surface-to-air missile, the Dutch Safety Board says. The missile was fired from rebel-held eastern Ukraine

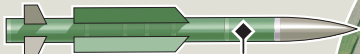
RECOVERED PLANE DEBRIS

Impact:

Warhead detonates one metre above and to left side of cockpit, killing all three crew. Forward section, 12.5m from nose, breaks off



Buk missile: Shrapnel found in bodies of crew is consistent with 9N314M warhead

Passengers: All people die or lose consciousness instantly

Air space: Ukraine should have closed air space over conflict zone



Missile fired from 320sq km area
