▲ The tomb of Queen Nefertari, the favourite wife of Egyptian Pharaoh Rameses II, was opened to visitors for the first time since its discovery in 1904

1965: Rhodesian Prime Minister Ian Smith declared a state of emergency ahead of his unilateral declaration of independence from Britain
