*November 6, 1935*

▲ The RAF's first monoplane, the Hawker Hurricane, took to the air for the first time. The aircraft played a key role in the Battle of Britain in 1940

**1935:** Edwin Armstrong, who pioneered FM broadcasting, presented a key paper about it in the United States

**1965:** Cuba and the U.S. formally agreed to begin an airlift for Cubans wanting to go to the United States

**1975:** British punk band the Sex Pistols played their first gig at St Martin's College of Art in London

**2005:** The military government in Burma began moving to Nay Pyi Daw, a new purpose-built capital
