▲ **Jubilant Berliners celebrated the fall of the Berlin Wall as the East German government threw open its border to West Berlin and West Germany**

1825: Limelight was used in a practical way for the first time, to enable a surveyor in Ireland to continue working despite misty weather

1967: Rolling Stone magazine, the first national rock and roll periodical in the U.S., published its first issue

1990: King Birendra of Nepal restored democracy to the Himalayan kingdom after proclaiming a new constitution

2005: Three suicide bomb attacks in Amman, Jordan, killed 60 people
