▲ **Chrysanthemums were introduced into England from China, where they were cultivated as a flowering herb as far back as the 15th century BC**

1675: German mathematician and philosopher Gottfried Leibniz demonstrated integral calculus, one of the two main operations in calculus, for the first time

1880: Australian outlaw Ned Kelly was hanged in Melbourne

1952: The first video recorder was demonstrated in the United States

1975: Angola became independent after 500 years under Portugal's colonial rule
