## Migrants stranded on new route to Europe

Tensions are rising among thousands of migrants blocked by border controls as they head for Western Europe through the Balkans



- 1 Greece: Short razor wire fence built in 2012 and increased security along border forces most migrants to take sea route from Turkey
- **2** Bulgaria: Construction of partial fence and border control efforts more than halved number of migrants entering from Turkey in 2014
- Hungary: Razor wire fences hastily constructed along frontier with Serbia and Croatia. Border closures forcing migrants to switch to slower route via Slovenia
- 4 Serbia: Buses with thousands of migrants waiting at Croatian border

- **5** Croatia: Struggling to cope with huge migrant influx almost 200,000 have entered country since mid-September, according to police. More than 5,000 people stuck in migrant camp in Opatovac
- **6 Slovenia:** Limiting flow of migrants to 2,500 per day
- **7 Austria:** Denies Slovenia's claim it will only accept 1,500 people a day
- **B** Germany: Temporary border controls extended until end of October. Country plans to take in 800,000 asylum seekers this year, but number could be as high as 1.5 million
