

# Singapore hosts WTA Finals 2015

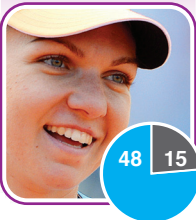
Following the withdrawal of Serena Williams, the world's best women tennis players contest the WTA Finals at Singapore's Indoor Stadium

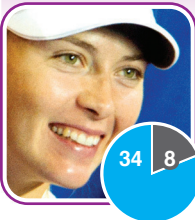
**2 Simona Halep**

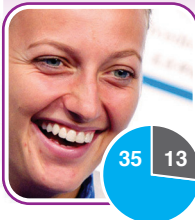
**4 Garbine Muguruza**

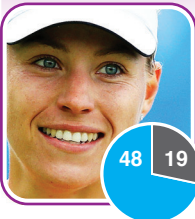
**6 Agnieszka Radwanska**

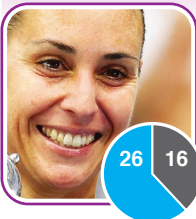
**7 Angelique Kerber**

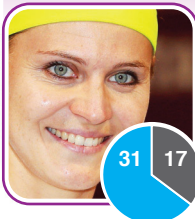
**8 Flavia Pennetta**
