


UK and China clinch multi-billion contracts

Britain and China have signed almost £30 billion (\$46bn) in trade deals as part of a drive to forge closer ties between the two countries



Oil and gas
£12bn

Oil and gas: Deals worth more than **£12 billion**, including **£6.5bn** liquefied natural gas (LNG) supply contract with China's Huadian power generator. BP will supply up to 1 million tonnes of LNG per year over 20 years

Nuclear energy
£6bn

Power station: China's state-owned CGN to take 33.5% stake worth up to **£6bn** in EDF's Hinkley Point C – first nuclear power plant to be built in UK since 1988

Ship building
£2.6bn

Cruise ships: American-British Carnival Corp. has signed **£2.6bn** contract to launch cruise brand aimed at Chinese audience. Deal funded by sovereign wealth fund, China Investment Corporation

Transport
£2bn

Transport: Falkirk-based Alex Dennis Limited and China's BYD have agreed **£2bn** deal to manufacture electric buses

Health
£2bn

Healthcare: More than **£2bn** of trade deals between Chinese and UK companies

Building
£1.7bn

Building: China's Citic is main contractor in **£1.7bn** Royal Albert Docks project

Aviation
£1.4bn

Aviation: **£1.4bn** Rolls Royce deal with China's aviation conglomerate HNA Group

Other: **£323m** GlaxoSmithKline deal, **£200m** for University of York TV training, **£194m** for Legoland park in Shanghai, **£100m** for British theme park, **£50m** each for Aston Martin and London Taxi Company
