

Climate change likely to increase world's poor

A World Bank report finds that climate change caused by increasing greenhouse gases could see the world's poor rise by over 100 million

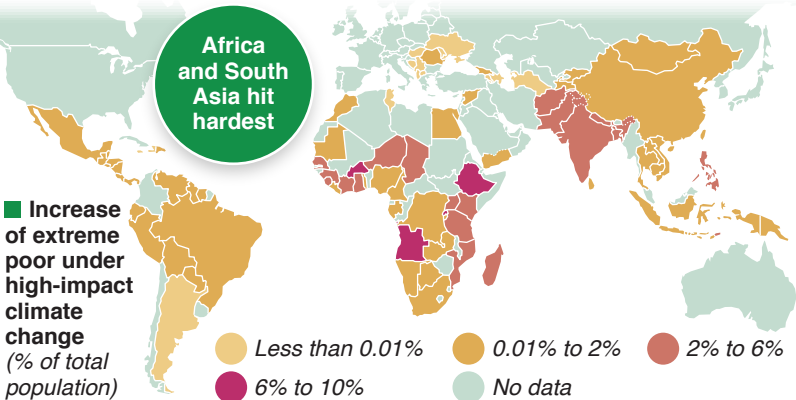
Global poverty, 2030 (worst case scenario)

People living in extreme poverty (if no climate change): **900m**

(Under best case scenario, those living in extreme poverty falls to 142m)

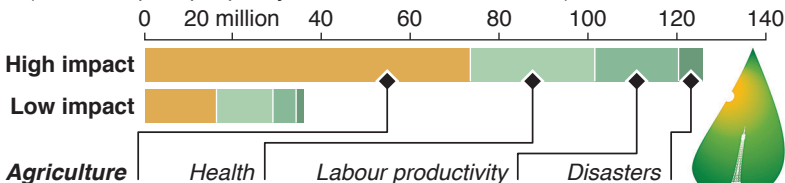
Low impact climate change:
Additional 35m poor

High impact climate change:
+122m poor



Agriculture – key driver in impact of poverty due to climate change

(additional poor people by driver, worst case scenario)
