

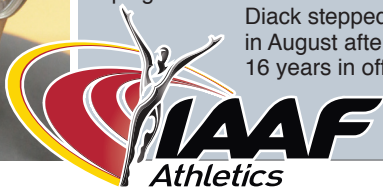
WADA commission calls for Russian ban

The World Anti-Doping Agency has recommended that Russia should be suspended from track and field competition after it examined allegations of systematic cheating and cover-ups in Russian athletics, which also implicated the IAAF, the sport's world governing body



▶ **Lamine Diack:** 82-year-old Senegalese former IAAF president under investigation by French police for allegedly taking over \$1 million in bribes in 2011 to cover up positive doping tests of Russian athletes.

Diack stepped down in August after 16 years in office



OTHERS FACING CHARGES

▶ **Papa Massata Diack:** Diack's son and former IAAF marketing consultant thought to have played "very active" role in alleged corruption

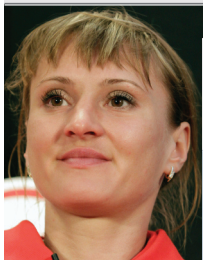
▶ **Valentin Balakhnitchiev:** Former head of Russian athletic federation accused of role in trying to blackmail athletes guilty of doping violations



Gabriel Dollé: Former head of IAAF's anti-doping department suspected of taking about \$220,000 in bribes



Alexei Melnikov: Former Russian chief coach has had over 20 of his athletes banned for doping offences



ATHLETE REVELATIONS

▶ **Liliya Shobukhova:** Marathon runner allegedly paid \$550,000 to Russian athletics federation to avoid doping ban before 2012 Olympics

▶ **Aslı Çakır Alptekin:** Turkish 1,500m Olympic champion in 2012 reportedly refused IAAF demand for \$500,000 to cover up doping offences
