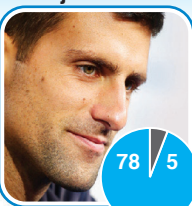

4 Stan Wawrinka



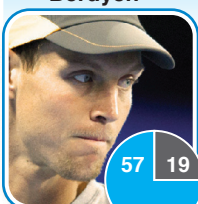
Surprise victory at Roland Garros denied Djokovic his calendar Grand Slam

Still competing with elite, aged 33. Reached final of ATP finale in 2007, losing to Federer

8 Kei Nishikori



Wins in Memphis, Barcelona and Washington took career total of ATP titles to 10
