Helmut Schmidt profile



- son of half-Jewish teacher
- 1939-45: Sees action in World War II – briefly held as prisoner of war by British forces
- 1953: Elected as lawmaker for Social Democratic Party
- 1969: Joins Willy Brandt's government as defence minister later serves as finance minister
- 1974: Elected Chancellor of West Germany after Brandt resigns. Credited with consolidating country's post-war economic boom, and seeking reconciliation with Soviet-bloc nations of eastern Europe
- 1982: Loses power to *Helmut Kohl* after coalition collapses
- 1983: Becomes publisher of influential weekly *Die Zeit*
- 1987: Retires from politics
 - Nov 10, 2015: Dies aged 96
