U.S. airstrike targets "Jihadi John"

A U.S. drone strike has targeted a vehicle in Syria believed to be carrying "Jihadi John" – the masked Islamic State militant who appears in several videos depicting the beheadings of Western hostages

- Aug 17, 1988
 Mohammed
 Emwazi born
 in Kuwait, moves
 to UK in 1994
- 2009: Completes computing degree at University of Westminster
- Aug 2009
 Travels to Tanzania with friends, allegedly on safari, but is refused entry. Reportedly questioned by security services as he returns home via Netherlands
- Sep 2009
 Travels to Kuwait to stay with father's family
- July 2010: Returns to UK for short stay but prevented from returning to Kuwait as visa denied
- 2012: Passes course to qualify in teaching English as foreign language
- 2013: Changes name by deed poll. Tries to travel to Kuwait but is stopped. Disappears. Parents report him missing. Police later tell family that he has gone
