▲ Italian architect **Andrea Palladio** was born. Heavily influenced by the principles of classical Rome, his work includes the church of **San Giorgio Maggiore in Venice**

1924: The first photographs were transmitted by radio across the Atlantic

1995: **Bill Clinton** became the first U.S. president to make a visit to Northern Ireland

2005: John Sentamu became the first black archbishop in the nearly 500-year history of the Church of England

2009: The **Large Hadron Collider** pushed the energy of its particle beams beyond one trillion electron volts, a new world record
