## Today in History

*December 4, 1918*

▲ **Woodrow Wilson set sail for France to attend the Versailles Peace Conference, becoming the first serving U.S. President to visit a foreign country**

**1945:** The U.S. Senate approved U.S. participation in the United Nations

**1965:** NASA launched the Gemini 7 spacecraft on a mission to link up with Gemini 6 and investigate the effects of space on the human body

**1995:** The first NATO troops landed in Sarajevo to enforce an accord ending four years of war in former Yugoslavia

**2013:** Xavier Bettel became the first openly gay Prime Minister of Luxembourg
