▲ Russian president Vladimir Putin met Fidel Castro in the first visit to Cuba by a Russian leader since the collapse of the Soviet Union in 1991

1900: Max Planck's Quantum Theory, stating that radiant energy comes in small indivisible packets, was published

1970: The first tenants moved into the newly constructed twin towers of the World Trade Centre in New York

1995: The leaders of Serbia, Croatia and Bosnia signed the Bosnia Peace Accord in Paris

2014: Police in Hong Kong cleared the main protest site 10 weeks after mass pro-democracy protests began
