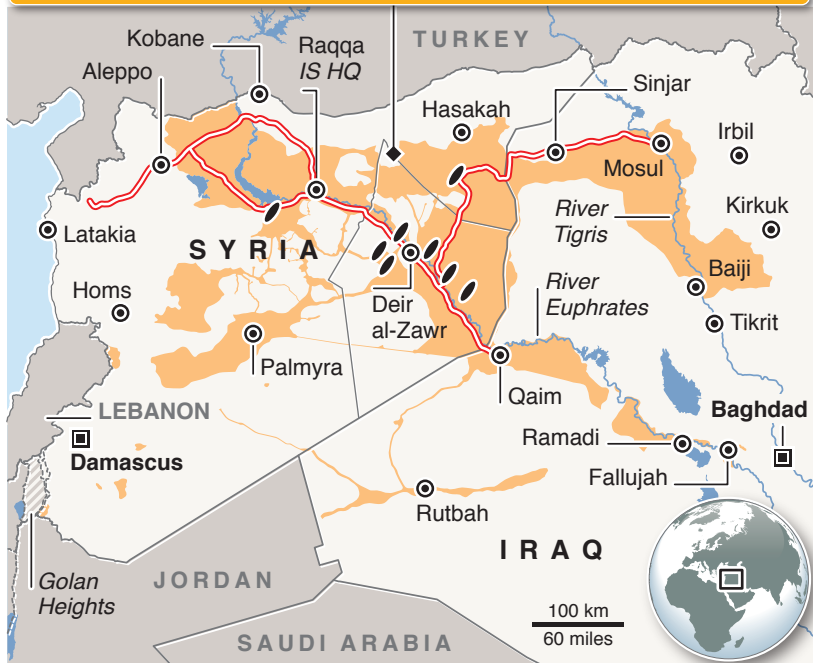


U.S. expanding airstrikes on Syrian oilfields

U.S.-led coalition airstrikes are targeting oilfields in Syria in an effort to sever a key revenue stream for the so-called Islamic State (IS). The oil trade is estimated to net the militant group about \$1.5 million a day

Deir al-Zawr region: Airstrikes concentrating on area which produces about two-thirds of IS group's oil revenue. Russia also targeting IS oil facilities

- Key IS-held oilfields
- Primary routes used by IS to transport oil
