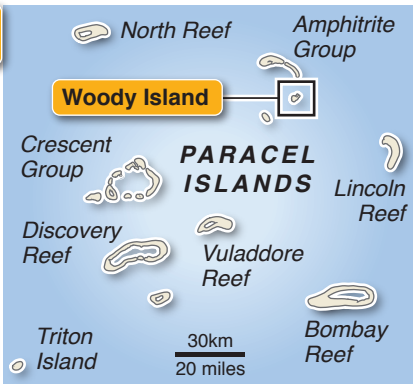
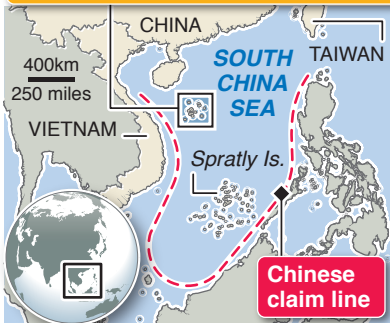


Sinopec building fuel station in S. China Sea
