1 Rank



1 Novak Djokovic (SRB) Age: 28

Enjoyed near total dominance in 2015, winning three of four Slams, six Masters titles and year-end Tour Finals. Aiming to launch new season with sixth Australian Open title



4 Stan Wawrinka (SUI) 30

Champion in 2014 and only player other than Djokovic to secure Slam title in 2015. Able to compete with world's best with intense gameplay and thunderous ground strokes



2 Andy Murray (GBR) 28

Boosted by recent Davis Cup victory, four-time finalist is looking to claim first Australian Open title, but is ready to leave tournament early to attend birth of his first child

5 Rafael Nadal (ESP) 29

Victory at exhibition event in Abu Dhabi marked perfect start to 2016 for 14-time major champion after continued struggles last year, including four defeats to Djokovic
