▲ **The Menai Suspension Bridge, designed by Thomas Telford and considered the world's first modern suspension bridge, was opened in Wales**

1958: French designer Yves St Laurent held his first Paris fashion show

1972: British soldiers shot dead 13 people in a banned Catholic civil rights march in Londonderry, Northern Ireland, in a clash known as “Bloody Sunday”

1973: In the U.S., Gordon Liddy and James McCord were convicted for their involvement in the Watergate scandal

2015: Kenji Goto, a Japanese video journalist was beheaded by ISIS
