

Travel warnings grow over Zika virus

The Zika virus, which may be linked to brain damage in thousands of babies, is prompting governments to issue travel warnings to pregnant women for countries where the tropical fever has been detected

Locally transmitted cases of Zika virus reported in last two months



Zika spread: Primarily through bite of infected *Aedes aegypti* mosquito. Virus may also pass from mother to foetus during pregnancy. Link between Zika and babies born with underdeveloped brains, or microcephaly, is still being investigated
