▲ **Russia formally annexed Crimea following a referendum in which 97 percent of voters in the strategic Black Sea region chose to secede from Ukraine**

1902: Italian tenor Enrico Caruso made the first good quality records

1931: The first electric razors were produced in the U.S. by Schick Inc.

2001: The World Water Forum warned that two in three people would face severe water shortages by 2025

2015: Gunmen killed 21 people, mostly European tourists, at a Tunis museum. ISIS claimed responsibility for the terror attack, at the time the deadliest in Tunisian history
