March 19, 1932

▲ **Australia's iconic Sydney Harbour Bridge officially opened. It is the world's tallest steel arch bridge, rising 134m (440ft) above water level at its highest point**

1931: The hangover cure Alka Seltzer was first marketed

1996: The **Bosnian capital Sarajevo** became a united city again after four years of warfare

2009: Austrian Josef Fritzl was jailed for life for the 24-year imprisonment and rape of his daughter

2011: Knut the polar bear, who became world famous when he was hand-reared by keepers at Berlin Zoo, died suddenly at the age of four
