▲ Canadian actor William Shatner, best known as Captain James T. Kirk, commander of the starship USS Enterprise, in Star Trek, was born. He turns 85 today

1919: The first international airline service was instituted

1993: Intel shipped the first Pentium chips (80586), featuring a 60 MHz clock speed

1996: A link was revealed between BSE, or “mad cow disease”, and a new strain of the brain-wasting Creutzfeld-Jakob disease in humans

2004: Sheikh Yassin, head of the Palestinian militant group Hamas, was killed in an Israeli air strike
