▲ **Gunmen stormed the Garissa University College in Garissa, Kenya, killing at least 148 people, mostly students. Al-Shabab militants claimed responsibility**

**1961:** The Aboriginal Advancement Council protested to all Federal MPs about apartheid in Australia

**1979:** The mass graves of the Khmer Rouge regime in Cambodia were first revealed

**1996:** Russia and Belarus created an alliance within the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS)

**1996:** Former Polish president Lech Walesa resumed his old job as an electrician at the Gdansk shipyard
