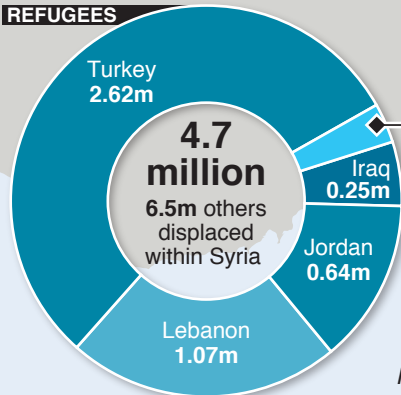

Five years of Syria's civil war

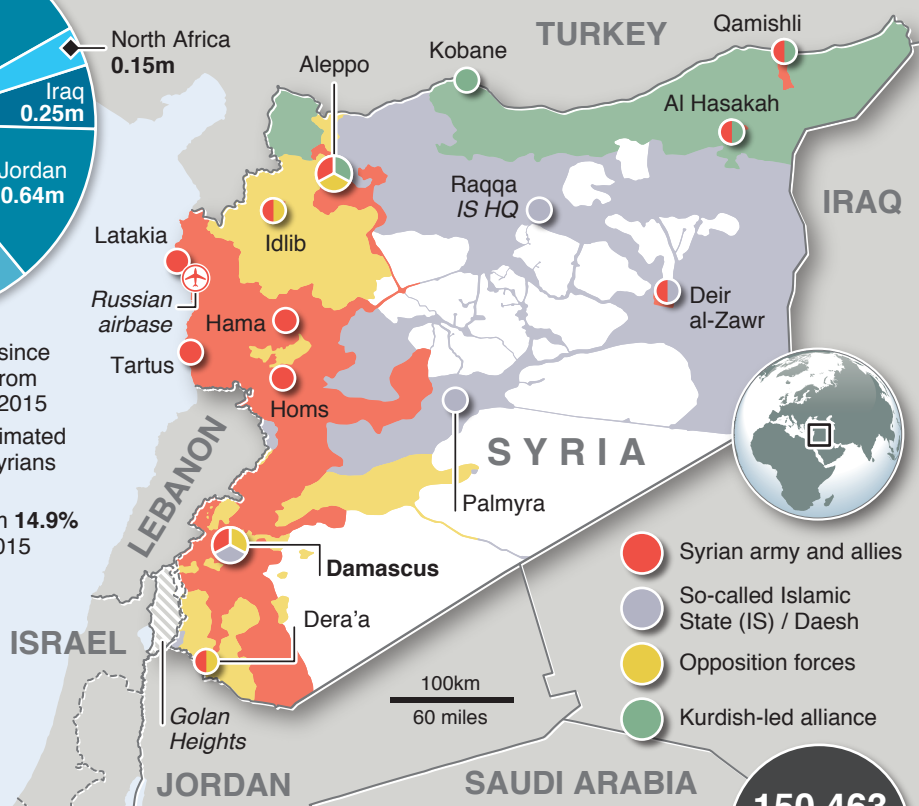
POPULATION Down by 21% since 2010. Life expectancy down from 75.9 years in 2010 to 55.4 in 2015

ECONOMY GDP down by estimated \$163bn. More than 85% of Syrians live below poverty line

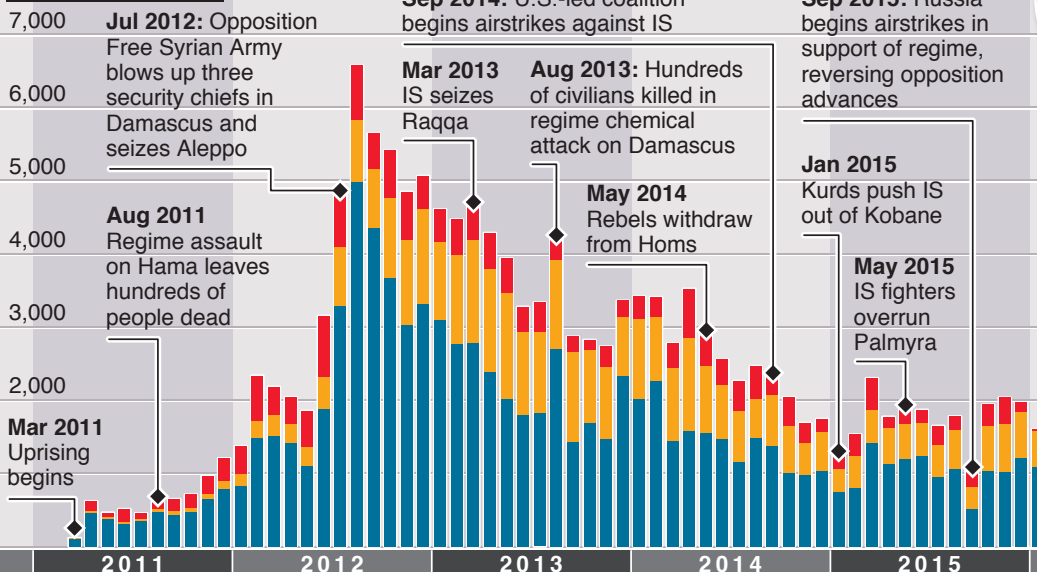
UNEMPLOYMENT Surged from 14.9% in 2011 to 52.9% by end of 2015

EDUCATION Over 45% of school-age children are no longer attending school

AID FUNDING Only 57% of funds provided in 2015 to meet total humanitarian aid requirements for Syria – down from 71% in 2013
