April 24, 1916

▲ **The Easter Rising, an armed rebellion aimed at ending British rule in Ireland, began. It was soon suppressed but eventually paved the way for Irish independence**

1923: Sigmund Freud published his seminal paper *Das Ich und das Es* (the Ego and the Id)

2001: An unmanned spy plane completed the first non-stop, robotic flight across the Pacific

2006: Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad lifted a ban on female attendance at public sporting events

2013: An eight-story garment factory collapsed in Dhaka, Bangladesh, killing over 1,100 people
