

Hospital attacks in Aleppo

A surge in fighting in Aleppo in the past two weeks has killed almost 300 people, with hospitals and civilian areas coming under attack from government warplanes and shelling from rebel forces

Rebel areas almost surrounded by Syrian regime, leaving only one supply line to Turkey

Apr 29: Ibn Rashid cardiac hospital hit by rebel shelling

Apr 29: Bustan Al-Qassar clinic hit by government

Apr 27: Government strike on **Al-Quds Hospital** kills 55 civilians, including six medics
