▲ Texan golfer Jordan Spieth won the U.S. Open at the age of 21. It was his second consecutive major victory following the U.S. Masters two months earlier

**1919:** The captured German fleet scuttled itself at Scapa Flow in Scotland

**1948: Columbia Records** introduced the first successful long-playing records

**1964:** Three U.S. civil rights workers disappeared after being arrested by Mississippi police. Their bodies were found six weeks later

**2006:** Two newly discovered moons of Pluto, since demoted to a “dwarf planet”, were named Nix & Hydra
