▲ Scientists announced they had found the oldest-known turtle, 240 million years old, that combined traits of lizard-like ancestors with emerging turtle-like features

1901: The first exhibition by Pablo Picasso, aged 19, opened in Paris

1953: Jacqueline Bouvier announced her engagement to rising U.S. Senator John F. Kennedy

1994: The world's largest cargo aircraft, the Beluga, was unveiled in Toulouse

2008: Plans were unveiled for the world's first swirling skyscraper in Dubai, with each floor rotating once an hour to form an ever-changing profile on the skyline
