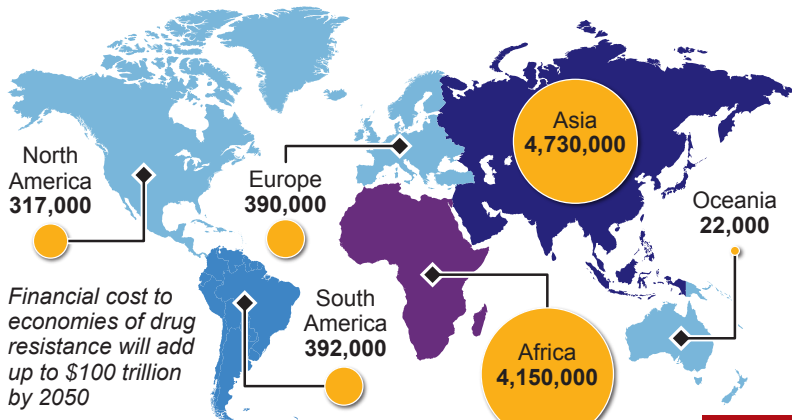


Superbugs “bigger risk than cancer”

An extra 10 million people could die every year by 2050 unless sweeping global changes are agreed to tackle increasing resistance to antibiotics
