▲ **The greatest tank battle in history ended with Russia's defeat of Germany at Kursk, south of Moscow. The battle involved 6,000 tanks and two million men**

1841: The Straits Convention was signed by the major European powers, guaranteeing the independence of the Ottoman Empire

1871: The world's first cat show was held at Crystal Palace in London

1997: The remains of Che Guevara were returned to Cuba after lying in a common grave in Bolivia for 30 years

2015: Scientists at CERN's Large Hadron Collider announced the observation of pentaquarks
