## Report in numbers

**Seven** Years since **Chilcot Inquiry** was launched. Report covers lead-up to invasion from 2001 to withdrawal of majority of British troops in 2009

**2.6 million** Words included in report – four times length of **War and Peace**

**150,000** Documents analysed

**150** Witnesses who gave evidence during more than 130 sessions

**\$13.3m** Estimated cost of report

**6-11 million** People that marched in up to 60 countries across world on Feb 16, 2003, to express opposition to imminent war in Iraq

**\$12.30bn** Cost of British funding of Iraq conflict (includes \$740m in aid)\*

**179** UK military personnel killed in Iraq during conflict in which tens of thousands of Iraqi civilians died
