## Today in History

*August 28, 1963*

▲ U.S. civil rights leader Martin Luther King delivered his famous “I Have a Dream” speech at a rally in Washington DC attended by 200,000 people

**1879:** Cetewayo, last of the great Zulu kings, was captured by the British

**1937:** Toyota Motors, founded as a department of Toyota industries to create automobiles, became an independent company

**1963:** The Evergreen Floating Bridge, at 2.31m the longest floating bridge in the world, opened between Seattle and Medina in the U.S. state of Washington

**1990:** Occupied Kuwait was declared the 19th province of Iraq
