▲ The **Vittoria**, captained by **Juan Sebastian Del Cano** since the death of **Magellan**, returned to **Seville** after completing the first circumnavigation of the world

1991: Leningrad, Russia's second largest city, reverted to its original name of Saint Petersburg

1997: The funeral of **Diana, Princess of Wales** was watched by roughly 2.5 billion TV viewers worldwide

2006: Japan celebrated the birth of a royal prince, the first boy born into the Imperial family for 41 years

2011: Famine in East Africa left 13 million people in need of emergency assistance
