▲ **Four teenagers following their dog after it disappeared down a hole near Lascaux, France, discovered cave wall paintings that proved to be 17,000 years old**

1958: The world's first integrated circuit, or microchip, was demonstrated in the United States

1977: South African black civil rights leader Steve Biko died in police detention in Pretoria

2002: Archaeologists reported the discovery in Lithuania of 100 skeletons believed to be Napoleonic soldiers

2015: Jeremy Corbyn won a landslide victory to become leader of Britain's opposition Labour party
