▲ U.S. Secretary of State Colin Powell named wealthy Saudi exile Osama bin Laden as the prime suspect behind the terror attacks on New York and Washington

1966: John Vorster was sworn in as prime minister of South Africa

2003: Sweden voted emphatically to reject the euro in a referendum

2006: The solar system's largest dwarf planet, previously designated 2003 UB313, was officially named Eris and its moon was called Dysnomia

2007: The Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples was adopted by the United Nations General Assembly
