*September 28, 1066*

▲ William, Duke of Normandy, landed at Pevensey, beginning the Norman Conquest of England. He was crowned king in London on Christmas Day of the same year

**1993:** Over 50 people were killed when a natural gas pipeline exploded alongside a busy highway in Venezuela

**2000:** Denmark rejected membership of the single European currency

**2006:** Bangkok's Suvarnabhumi International Airport, featuring the world's largest terminal building and tallest control tower, was opened

**2015:** Pro-independence parties in Catalonia won an absolute majority in Spain's regional elections
